A pay increase for the staff was also proposed to \$10.50 for Ken, Judy, Catherine, and Kathy (Amber moved, Wendy seconded, all approved.
- **b.** Possible July closure-The library may close for a day or two in July to accommodate for staffing/vacations.
- c. Tim Erickson sent a new logo for the board to consider; it was discussed and will be considered at the next meeting.
- d. Dollhouse donation Jamie Stiffarm has a large dollhouse that she wants to donate to the library. After discussion it was agreed that there was no adequate space to put it but the board would consider it for the silent auction if she is willing.
- e. RIDES deliveries The delivery contract is uncertain, Waltco (the delivery service) is working month to month and has told the cooperatives they may do at any point due to costs. SLC is continually monitoring situation. The cooperative is also increasing the subsidy to the library for RIDES to \$1000 for the upcoming fiscal year to offset the \$1800 RIDES cost.
